

BEAUMARIS, ISLE OF ANGLESEY

Directions to The Bulkeley Hotel from......

Holyhead Port (time taken approximately 40 minutes)

- Leave the port area and head for the A55 -signposted Bangor / Chester
- Exit the A55 at Junction 8 signposted Benllech and Amlwch
- Turn left onto the A5025 towards Benllech / Amlwch
- Once at roundabout take the third exit onto Ffordd Pentraeth B5420 signposted Menai Bridge / Beauamris
- At the second roundabout take the first exit signposted Town Centre
- At the T junction turn left onto the A545 signposted Beaumaris
- See last paragraph for further directions...

Caernarfon (time taken approximately 30 minutes)

- Head out of Caernarfon on the A487 signposted Bangor
- You will eventually go on a bypass which starts up a very steep hill
- At the next roundabout take the second exit still the A487 signposted Holyhead / A55 (again going up a very steep hill)
- At the top you will reach another roundabout, take the third exit still on the A487 signposted Bangor
- Another roundabout and take the first exit, still the A487 signposted Bangor
- You will approach another roundabout (there will be a pub on your left The Antelope) you need to take the first exit onto the A5 over the bridge signposted Menai Bridge
- Once you are back on dry land, you need to take the second exit on the roundabout A545 signposted Beaumaris – you will drive through Menai Bridge Town Centre

Betwys -y – Coed (time taken approximately 45 minutes)

- Exit Bewys y Coed along the A5 towards Bethesda / Bangor
- Stay on this road, pass Capel Cuirg and through the Nant yr Ogwen Valley (be wary the roads along here can be windy)
- Continue through the town of Bethesda
- You will eventually approach a mini roundabout for the travelodge, go straight over onto the big roundabout and take the first exit onto the A55 signposted Holyhead
- Stay on this road and you will go over the Britannia Bridge
- Immediatley after you exit the bridge leave the A55 on Junction 8A signposted Llanfairpwllgwyngyll / Menai Bridge and many tourist attractions
- Merge into the right hand lane and at the T junction turn right onto the A5 signposted Menai
 Bridge / Beaumaris
- Stay on this road and enter Menai Bridge
- You will then approach a rounabout (a shell garage will be opposite you) take the second exit signposted Town Centre
- At the T junction turn left onto the A545 signposted Beaumaris

Chester (time taken approximately 1hr 30 minutes)

- As you leave Chester, head for the A548 signposted Queensferry
- Stay on this road entering Sealand
- At the roundabout taken the first exit and then merge onto the A494 signposted Conwy A55
- Continue forward onto the Aston Hill staying on the A494
- Follow signs for Conwy A55 and remain on the A55, which covers the North Wales coastline the last big town you will pass will be Bangor
- Immediatley after you exit the bridge leave the A55 on Junction 8A signposted Llanfairpwllgwyngyll / Menai Bridge and many tourist attractions
- Merge into the right hand lane and at the T junction turn right onto the A5 signposted Menai Bridge / Beaumaris
- Stay on this road and enter Menai Bridge
- You will then approach a rounabout (a shell garage will be opposite you) take the second exit signposted Town Centre
- At the T junction turn left onto the A545 signposted Beaumaris
- See last paragraph for further directions...

Continuation of directions for all routes from the town of Menai Bridge

- Continue on this road, be wary the road does become very windy and narrow just before approaching Beaumaris
- As you enter Beaumaris go straight through the town
- When you exit the town you will see the Castle on your left hand side
- As you go round the castle moat you will see a turning to the right by the town's green just before a set of traffic lights
- Turn right and when you bear round to the sea front you will see us on the right hand side more or less opposite the towns pier.
